

## Creating flu at risk searches

In this section you will be shown how to:

- Create flu at risk searches for any of the at risk groups




With the data loaded from EMIS, PatientChase separates the data into age categories meaning you can select or combine specific age groups or select the overarching all at risk category.

Step 1 - Run a sync (once you have completed the guide on loading PatientChase with flu at risk data)


Go to Search>EMIS Sync

This will update PatientChase with your latest flu at risk data.



Step 2 - Create a new search

Add>Not in Target>Hover the mouse over the IMMUNISATIONS register and move the mouse directly to the right and select the flu at risk target/s so they highlight blue.




In this example, the overarching 'Flu Jab All Groups' target is selected which covers all the targets below it.

Should you wish for example to select all those aged 50 and above, then select both 'FluJab Over 65' and 'FluJab 50 to 64' targets.

You can select any combination of targets.

Now name the search and click Finish Search.

Step 3 - View the list of patients



Click on the + symbol next to the search name.

Then click on the word 'Results'.

Your list of flu at risk patients will be displayed on the right.

Use PatientChase to now contact the patients via SMS, email or letter.
